I. The meeting was called to order by Reza Namavar at 2:10 PM

Mr. Sanders started by saying let's get along, work together and have Communication.

He recommended using the arbiter software for all state soccer events. Mr. Sanders discussed the benefits that the software has for assigners as well as for referees.

- b) Mr. Jalal Daneshfar – President, OCCSL. Mr. Daneshfar reported that the College league shall have 8 teams with seven teams from the state of Oklahoma colleges and one team from Arkansas. Mr. Daneshfar added that the league games shall start on September 13, 2009 and finish by November 21, 2009.

- c) Graham Weidner – Altus Adult Soccer Club. Mr. Weidner reported that they have four teams but he said the number of teams may go up to six teams.
