4. **Shae Roggendorff – President, NEOASA.** Present. Shae reported: (1) that NEOASA will start the Fall Season September 7, 2008; (2) that NEOASA had 62 teams during the Spring Season; (3) that the Summer League also was successful; (4) that NEOASA's revenues are up; and, (5) that the Soktoberfest Tournament would be October 17-19, 2008. Shae also explained that NEOASA had held their "first ever" Champions Day following the Spring Season which was a picnic held the last day of the Spring Season to recognize and present awards to the teams which finished 1st in their respective Divisions and to express NEOASA's appreciation to all its Team Reps and players.
