I. Call to Order.

The meeting was called to order by Second Vice President, Tekleab Tsegay, at 1:27 p.m.

Tekleab Tsegay asked the members if anyone had questions on the minutes. Then a motion was made to approve the minutes from January 27, 2006, by Shae Roggendorff and seconded by Randy Venk. The motion was passed unanimously.

II. Officer Reports

- a) **Jalal Daneshfar – OSA Adult Division , President.** Absent. No report.
- b) **Vance Brown – 1st Vice President, OSA Adult Division.** Absent. No Report.
- c) **Tekleab Tsegay – 2nd Vice President, OSA Adult Division.** Tekleab Tsegay reported on the State Championship. There were six (6) teams in Division 1, with OU taking first, and three (3) teams in Division 2, with Liberty taking first. Overall the State Championship went well.
- d) **Rob Breitenstein - Secretary/Registrar/Cups Commissioner.** Rob reported that, contrary to the documents provided by Sid Goodrich related to the voting structure, Unity Soccer does not have votes since they have not been approved by the Adult Membership or the General Membership according to the Bylaws.
- e) **Paul Scott - State Referee Administrator.** Absent. Dale Watts gave a SRA report. Dale reported there were 16,000 referees in the State of Oklahoma and over 70 referee classes to date. 75% of the referees are under the age of 20. Dale commented that we

need more referees for the Adult Leagues and is willing to work with the Adult Leagues at any cost and class schedule. Rob asked Dale if there is anything that could be done to keep referees from officiating non-affiliated games. Dale commented that there is nothing that can be done as they are private contractors.

- f) **Randy Venk – President, Central Oklahoma Adult Soccer League (COASL).** Randy reported they are having scheduling problems without Raymond. Some referee problems as wells. They were planning to have a summer league.

- g) **Shae Roggendorff – President, Northeast Oklahoma Adult Soccer Association (NEOASA).** Shae reported that the season was going well. They are having some scheduling problems with their co-ed league in its second season. Soktoberfest will be October 20-22, 2006. They are adding a U-19 Division and that they have a new website for Soktoberfest at www.soktoberfest.com.
- h) **Kooroush Azartagh-Namin – Representative, Rose State College, Oklahoma Collegiate Club Soccer League (OCCSL).** Kooroush reported that the league playoffs started today. The colleges are all moving forward with the support of their teams. Most colleges have one (1) team per college and OSU has two (2) teams. They are looking forward to the college community’s support and for new players coming to school in the fall. International Club teams are starting to join the college leagues and they have no referee assignor as the league is not big enough.
- i) **Kevin Krager - President, Ponca City Soccer Association (PCSA).** Absent. No report.

Vance Brown was voted in as First Vice President and was unable to attend today’s meeting because of an illness in the family.

IV. New Business

- a) **Bylaw 211 and Grievance.** Mike Thornton talked about OSA’s Bylaws and the grievance filed with OSA by NEOASA (there was open discussion).
- b) **Veteran’s Cup.** Motion was made by Shae Roggendorff, seconded by Randy Venk, that the Men’s O-50 team representing Oklahoma would receive \$100.00 support from OSA Adult Division. The motion was passed unanimously.
