\$1.00 Youth Registration fee increase: Motion was made to increase youth registration fee by \$1.00. Motion dies for lack of second.

Insurance Escrow Fund: Program ideas by Randy Donalson. To do 2 things, 1 – Scholarship for college bound players and 2 Clubs can apply for grant money. Motion to use this insurance escrow fund with guidelines that were given. Seconded and passed

Motion from GCSA: Policy for State Cup 2001. All Oklahoma soccer sanctioned teams must compete in at least a 4-team sanctioned league prior to the State Cup. The league competition must consist of a minimum of one games against each of three different teams participating in the league. Beginning 2001 State Cup. Seconded and passed.

Motion from FCSC: Motion to rescind 12-98 policy with new policy of Under 8 and Under 10 recreational teams should be allowed to attend out of state tournaments per OSA travel policy. Seconded and passed.
