Scholarship Application

Scholarship Application Procedures

1. Please review the 2009/2010 Estimated ODP Event Cost Sheet that is provided as part of this application. This cost sheet contains a breakdown and explanation of costs and which costs are available for scholarship.
2. If upon reviewing the estimated event cost sheet a need for scholarship exists then please complete the ODP Scholarship form. The form must include the past year's income tax returns (2008).
3. Scholarship applications will only be accepted once per year. Families applying will only need to apply once for scholarship aid for all events.
4. ALL applying families will be notified by email of their scholarship figure. The form that will be used for notification is part of the scholarship application.
5. The scholarship figure granted represents the amount of aid that each family will receive for each event that their child is selected to attend.
6. Scholarship figures will be based on need and will be assigned as follows:
 - a. Payment Plan: This assessment means that the family is able to arrange for a periodic payment schedule for their event fees. Each payment plan will be a mutually agreed upon time period and amount that will cover the outstanding balance. In some instances a payment plan may be included with another scholarship figure.
 - b. 25%: This assessment means that the family is responsible for 75% of the event fee. This event fee is due prior to the player traveling or participating in the event.
 - c. 50%: This assessment means that the family is responsible for 50% of the event fee. This event fee is due prior to the player traveling or participating in the event.
 - d. 75%: This assessment means that the family is responsible for 25% of the event cost.
 - e. Airline Tickets: OSA does not typically scholarship the cost of airline tickets to ODP events. In rare instances, OSA will cover this cost. If it is determined at an airline ticket needs to be covered based on the families applications this will be included in the scholarship aid provided.
7. **Submit the following:**
 - a. Completed application
 - b. All appropriate tax forms
 - c. Breakdown of monthly income/expenses. Please include any circumstances that would affect your need for financial assistance.
 - d. Submit ALL paperwork ***by Monday, December 29, 2009***. Scholarships for events will be handled on a case-by-case basis. Please submit all application materials to the following address:
