

GUEST PLAYERS POLICY AND PROCEDURES

Tournaments and friendly games both in Oklahoma and with another National State Association may allow for the participation of guest players. A guest player is a U.S. Youth, currently registered player not rostered to the team participating in the tournament or friendly games. Guest players cannot participate in league competitions unless permitted by sub-regional or regional competitions. The tournament or friendly games hosting application approved by the National State Association will detail if guest players are allowed to participate and the number of guest players permitted per team. The use of guest players shall be in accordance with the following procedures:

1. Local club and country association policies are adhered to concerning releasing a player for guest play.
2. Teams shall only use guest players that are appropriate to the age group.
3. Guest player forms can be completed on-line with an e-travel form or in the OSA office.
4. Before proceeding with e-Travel, please check to make sure that you have the following items to insure that guest players are eligible to participate with your team:
 - a. A player must be currently registered with U.S. Youth Soccer and have the following proof of registration: player pass or copy of registration form.
 - b. Copy of the tournament hosting application demonstrating guest players are allowed and the total number of guest players that may participate with your team.
5. Approved guest players will need the following when traveling:
 - a. Current U.S. Youth player pass or registration form for recreational players in age levels that do not issue players' passes. (Note: Always check with the tournament to insure a player's registration form will be accepted.)
 - b. Signed medical release form
6. Under 11 and above recreational players may guest play with competitive or recreational teams. All rostered recreational players on a team must be invited to participate in a tournament before any guest players may be invited. Only recreational teams participating in out-of-state tournaments may invite recreational players to guest play.
7. A registered competitive player may not guest play with a recreational team.
8. Under 10 and below recreational players may not participate as guest players in tournaments or friendly games.
9. OSA state tournaments and in-state recreational tournaments do not allow guest player participation.
