I'm excited to share the official rosters for this weekend's Sub-Regional Friendlies. As you look through the document, here are a few quick pointers to help you understand how your player is being used and how to find their schedule: ([via link](#))

1. Some players are “double-rostered.”

Throughout the rosters, you'll notice a note at the bottom of each page stating that players *can be double-rostered*. This simply means certain players are asked to contribute to more than one team this weekend. This is intentional — it creates additional playing opportunities, supports competitive balance, and allows our staff to evaluate players in different game environments.

2. Check the “Rostering On” column carefully.

Each page lists:

- First & Last Name
- Gender
- **Rostering On** (team(s) they are assigned to)
- Birth Year
- Position

If your player's name appears under more than one team, that means they'll have multiple game assignments. For example, some players in the 14G and 14B age groups appear on both “Gray” and “Orange” rosters. Others in 16/17 groups show assignments to both primary and “Orange” teams. Please make sure to look at both rosters listed for your child.

3. Goalkeepers are highlighted.

You'll notice GK positions are shaded in yellow on several pages for clarity. This helps you immediately recognize which players will be covering goalkeeping responsibilities for each roster.

4. Your child's schedule depends on the team(s) listed.

After confirming the team(s) your child is rostered on, simply match those teams with the game schedule you received. If a player is double-rostered, they may have more games than others — all within safe play-time guidelines and appropriate rest windows.

5. Nothing is “wrong” if your child is not on the team you expected.

This weekend is a Talent ID event — our staff intentionally moves players into different environments to stretch, challenge, and support their growth. Every assignment is purposeful.
